Answers to math problems:

Addition – Sum Subtraction – Difference Multiplication – Product Division - Quotient

Mathematical statement (expression) - A collection of numbers and symbols.

- 5+6
- 9 x 4
- 8-7

Variable - A letter that represents an unknown.

<u>Variable Expression</u> – An expression that contains a variable

- a + 3
- 9 y
- 6 x m

Equation – A mathematical statement with an "=" sign in it.

<u>Solve/Evaluate</u> – Find the answer. The <u>solution</u> is the answer that makes the statement true.

Solve an Equation (Evaluate) - The process used to solve an equation. Find the Answer.

<u>Solution of an Equation</u> – the value of the variable (unknown) that makes the statement true.

$$13 + r = 24$$

$$r = 11$$

$$d - 6 = 12$$

$$d=18$$
